**Starter Usage**

Remove all starters w hen fatigued, or a situation below dictates a change:  
 Snell and May pitch until fatigued.  
 Eflin and Garret pitch thru 7, then leave if Braves up 2, 1, tied or dow n 1.  
 Elder leaves after 6 innings if Braves up 3, 2, 1 tied or dow n 1.  
 All pitchers leave in 9th for Iglesias in save situation.

**Relief Usage**

Remove all relievers when they become fatigued, or face their batter limit

**Computer: Please remove Iglesias after 30 pitches, Harvey/Armstrong 35 or innings/batter limit**

Iglesias Closer: 9th on when it is a save situation or when tied.

Not more than 2 innings or 6 batters unless last game of series

**Injured Reserve**

Ian Anderson ATL

Harvey Set Up: 7th on and Braves up 3 to tied. Never pitch more than 2 innings or 8 batters. Use as CL when Iglesias is unavailable.

Armstrong Set up 2: 6th inning on, Braves up 3 to down by 1. Limit 2 IP or 8 batters

Garcia Set up 3: 6th inning onward, when the above 3 not needed.

limit 1 IP per game and 2 IP per series.

Chapman Any situation where above pitcher not qualified. Pitch until tired

Stephenson Any situation where above pitcher not qualified. Pitch until tired

Try to have either Chapman or Stephenson available for each game, use the other as needed to keep that the case

**Extra Innings: If game goes extra innings then pitch from top to bottom of list but do not replace one of top 3 until inning/batter limit reached.**

**Offensive Strategy: order of usage: steal - hit and run - bunt**

**Pinch Run : Never**

**Stealing**

**Acuna will steal often. Let him run if he meets the minimum steal rating requirement, and game is within 5 runs**

2nd Base: If adjusted steal is 7 or greater then steal. Only steal if game is with 4 runs either way. Do not steal if runners on 1st and 3rd and 2 out, unless the runners stealing 2nd is an 10 or greater.

3rd base: If adjusted steal is 9 or greater and 1 out.

**Hit and Run**

Not this year, thank you.

**Base running**

Send all base runners if their adjusted BR is equal to or greater than the number listed for the situation.

**Defensive Strategy**

### **Throwing**

1. Cut down any runner 7 or less.
2. Cut down any runner 10 or less at the plate, if it's the tying run 7th on.
3. Cut down go ahead run at the plate 8th on no matter what the rating.
4. Cut down all base stealers of 9 or less

### **Infield In**

9th on, if tying or winning run is on 3rd and less than 2 out.

### **Holding Runners On**

Hold all runners
