#### OFFENSIVE & DEFENSIVE SUBSTITUTIONS

#### If losing in 7th inning on with RHP in the game:

- \*1 Marlowe will PH for DeJong. Marlowe stays in at CF, Edman moves to SS and Marcano replaces Cf'er (Doyle/Grichuk) and plays 2B.
- \*2 Baddoo will PH for Doyle. Baddoo stays in at RF, Grichuk moves to CF.
- Marlowe will PH for Tovar. Marlowe stays in at LF, Taylor moves to 3B, Aledmys Diaz moves to 2B and Edman moves to SS.

#### If losing in 7th inning on with LHP in the game:

- \*4 Marlowe will PH for Baddoo and stay in LF. Taylor will move to CF.
- \*5 Nola will PH for Haase and stay in at C.

#### If winning from the 7th inning on:

**Bottom of 7th Inning:** Marlowe replaces Grichuk and plays CF versus RHP, and LF versus LHP.

\*DEF Bottom of 9th Inning (If available use the following personnel):

Outfield configuration: CF - Doyle, LF - Marlowe, RF - Taylor. Infield configuration: 1B - Y. Diaz, 2B - Marcano, 3B - A. Diaz, SS - Tovar/Edman,

C - Haase.

#### OFFENSE (Use strategies below if Game is +/- 3 Runs)

STEAL: 2nd Base: If adjusted steal rating is 6 or greater. 3rd Base: If adjusted steal rating is 8 or greater... Look to STEAL OFTEN

BUNT: Game within one run - with runner on 1st, or 1st and 2nd, with 0 out or 1 out, Aledmys Diaz, Doyle and Tovar will bunt.

HIT & RUN: No Thank you...

PINCH HITTER: utilize OFFENSIVE & DEFENSIVE Substitutions chart above - use best available player in any other obvious PH situations.

PINCH RUNNING: If in 9th inning and behind by 1, PR (with 6+ speed runner on bench) for any 3 speed or worse baserunner.

BASE RUNNING: If Adjusted Baserunning (ABR) below is met or exceeded, attempt the extra base.

#### **DEFENSE**

HOLDING RUNNERS: Always hold baserunners with an ASR of 4 or greater.

INFIELD IN: if there is runner on 3rd and represents the winning run (9th inning on) or tying run (8th or 9th inning on)

**CORNERS IN:** if there is a runner on 1 st with 0 or 1 out, or runners on 1 st or 2 nd with 0 out, game within 2 runs and the batter is 4+ bunter

INTENTIONAL WALK: Best judgement, but only if 1 or 2 out and 1st base is open, 'Clutch' or solid batter at plate with weaker hitter next.

THROWING OPTIONS: For STEAL ATTEMPTS - Always throw!

- 1. Throw for <u>lead runner</u> trying to stretch with an **ABR of 8 or less** <u>if other runners on</u>.
- 2. Throw for <u>any runner</u> trying to stretch <u>if lone runner</u>.
- 3. Throw for <u>tying run</u> with an **ABR of 9 or less** and other runners on. Always throw if lone runner.
- 4. Always throw if runner is go ahead run from 8th inning on.
- 5. On Defensive Manager Choice Plays always take sure out(s) unless run is going home and we will lose the lead in 8<sup>th</sup> inning on.

**C** - Haase / Nola / Barrera, **1B** - Aledmys Diaz, **2B** - Marcano / Aledmys Diaz, **3B** - Taylor / Yandy Diaz, **SS** - Tovar / DeJong / Marcano / Edman, **CF** - Doyle / Grichuk / Marlowe / Edman, **OF** - Baddoo / Marlowe or next best available player.

#### STARTING PITCHER USAGE NOTES

**RELIEVER USAGE NOTES** 

- 1) Always remove Starters when fatigued unless ahead by 5+ runs or pitching a 2+ run shutout, then remove if tying run on base, at bat, or on deck.
- 2) Always remove Starter if 5 earned runs allowed or 7 total runs allowed.
- 3) If starter is pulled early, and Zack Littell is not pitching in the series, he will be the first option to get to the middle relievers. Merryweather is the Long relief option if Littell is not available.

#### **BULLPEN**

- 1) For Relief Pitchers, see the 'Relief Ptcher Instructions Chart' and the 'Game Situation Chart' below. Utilize the Relief Pitcher Instructions Chart to determine the general use requirements and then reference the Game Situation Chart to determine the specific order of precedence (Work down the list representing the appropriate inning and situation).
- 2) Always check at the start of an inning to see if the game situation has changed or if the next reliever per the preference list is due to come into the game.
- 3) Do not hesitate to look for match-ups to gain platoon advantage utilizing middle relievers and set-up guys to get to the 9th.
