DIAMOND MIND - COMPUTER GAME INSTRUCTIONS

OFFENSIVE SUBSTITUTIONS

- *1 If losing in the 7th inning on, Noel will Pinch Hit for Benintendi and stay in the game in RF.
- *2 If losing in the 8th inning on, facing a LHP or RHP with no baserunners, Lopez will PH for Clement and stay in the game at SS.

OTHER PINCH HITTING (9th Inning on)

In the 9th Inning on, if a power hitter or better on-base option is required or better Left/Right match-up available, use the following players:

DEFENSIVE SUBSTITUTIONS

Bottom of 9th (make the following changes): Outfield configuration: CF Pham, LF - Canha, RF - Noel. Infield configuration: 1B - Calhoun, 2B - Bogaerts, 3B - Devers, SS - Witt, C - Fermin.

OFFENSE (Use strategies below if Game is +/- 3 Runs)

STEAL: Always attempt to steal 2nd or 3rd with 1 or 2 out if rating is VG or better. If down 2+ in the 8th inning on, only attempt if rating EX.

BUNT: Not in Diamond Mind platform.

HIT & RUN: Clement (SP) will always H&R with 1 or 2 out and runners on 1st or 1st and 2nd (unless Pitcher has more than 70 BB's).

PINCH HITTER: Utilize chart above - work down the list and use the hitters anytime after the inning indicated in obvious PH situations

PINCH RUNNING: If in 9th inning and behind by 1, Pinch Run (with VG or EX speed runner on bench) for any FR or PR speed baserunner.

BASE RUNNING:

** PRIMARY: Set the "Running / Throwing" option to Computer Control.**

** SECONDARY CHOICE: Use table to the right:

DEFENSE

HOLDING RUNNERS: Always hold AV or better baserunners.

INFIELD IN: If there is runner on 3rd and represents the winning run (9th inning on) or tying run (8th or 9th inning on)

CORNERS IN: If there is a runner on 1 st with 0 or 1 out, or runners on 1 st or 2 nd with 0 out, game within 2 runs and the batter is VG bunter.

INTENTIONAL WALK: Best judgement, but only if 1 or 2 out and 1st base is open. Clutch or very good batter at plate with weaker hitter next.

THROWING OPTIONS: For STEAL ATTEMPTS - Always throw!

1. Throw for $\underline{lead\ runner}$ trying to stretch if \overline{VG} or \underline{less} baserunner and $\underline{other\ runners\ on}$.

2. Throw for any runner trying to stretch if lone runner.

** PRIMARY OPTION: Set the "Running / Throwing" option to Computer Control.**

- 3. Throw for tying run if baserunner is **VG** or less and other runners on. Always throw if lone runner.
- 4. Always throw if runner is go ahead run from 8th inning on.
- 5. On Defensive Manager Choice Plays always take sure out(s) unless run is going home and we will lose the lead in 8th inning on.

STARTING PITCHER USAGE NOTES

- 1) Always remove Starters when fatigued unless ahead by 5+ runs or pitching a 2+ run shutout, then remove if tying run on base, at bat, or on deck. Always remove if 5 earned runs allowed or 7 total runs allowed.
- 2) Notwithstanding note (1) above, try and get a minimum of 3 innings out of starters especially if KC has scored 3 or more runs in the first three-(3) innings.
- 3) Remove Singer, Urina or Ross in save situation in the 9th regardless of whether or not fatigued.
- 4) If starter is pulled early and Ross is not pitching in the series, he can be the used to get to the middle relievers (see below).

BULLPEN

1) For Relief Pitchers, see the 'Relief Ptcher Instructions Chart' and the 'Game Situation Chart' below. Utilize the Relief Pitcher Instructions Chart to determine the general use requirements and then reference the Game Situation Chart to determine the specific order of precedence.

DELIEF DITCHED INSTRUCTIONS CHART

- 2) Always check at the start of an inning to see if the game situation has changed or if the next reliever per the preference list is due to come into the game.
- 3) Do not hesitate to look for match-ups to gain platoon advantage utilizing middle relievers and set-up guys to get to the 9th. Royals do not have an actual Closer, Paredes is the primary option, but Banks (mostly LHB lineups) and/or Garcia (mostly RHB lineups) can fill in as required. Look for best match-ups.
